A HOUSE RESOLUTION PROVIDING THAT THE GOVERNOR'S WITHOLDING
OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT REIMBURSEMENTS BE THE SAME
PERCENTAGE AS HIS REQUIRED 3.6% REDUCTIONS OF ALL STATE
AGENCIES.

5 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

SECTION 1. The House of Representatives directs the Committee on Appropriations in preparing the budget to restore the withheld local government reimbursements. The reimbursements shall instead be cut by the same three and six-tenths percent (3.6%) requested elsewhere in the budget.
