A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH SENATORIAL DISTRICTS AND TO APPORTION SEATS IN THE SENATE AMONG DISTRICTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 120-1 is rewritten to read:

"(a) For the purpose of nominating and electing members of the Senate in 2002 and every two years thereafter, senatorial districts are established and seats in the Senate are apportioned among those districts so that each district elects one Senator, except for Districts 13, 16, and 28, each of which elects two Senators, and the composition of each district is as follows:

THIS IS A PARTIAL DISTRICTING PLAN COVERING ONLY DISTRICTS 17, 22, 35, 38, AND 47.

28 (b) The names and boundaries of precincts (voting tabulation districts), tracts,
29 block groups, and blocks specified in this section are as they were legally defined and
30 recognized in the 2000 United States Census. Boundaries are as shown on the
31 Redistricting Census 2000 TIGER Files, with modifications made by the Legislative
32 Services Office on its computer database as of May 1, 2001, to reflect precincts divided
33 or renamed as outlined in subsection (c) of this section. However, in Robeson County
34 PHILADEPLUS is, in fact, PHILADELPHUS, and in Vance County SANDY SCREEK
35 is, in fact, SANDY CREEK. If the boundary line between Iredell and Mecklenburg
36 Counties in the Redistricting Census 2000 TIGER Files conflicts with that provided by
37 Section 1 of Session Law 1998-15 as amended, Section 1 of Session Law 1998-15 as
38 amended prevails to the extent of the conflict.

39 (c) The Legislative Services Office modified on its computer database some of
40 the precincts shown on the Redistricting Census 2000 TIGER Files to reflect precincts
41 divided or renamed by county boards of elections after the TIGER Files were

1 completed. As a result, precincts are shown differently on the Legislative Services
2 Office computer database from the TIGER Files in the following counties:

3 (1) Buncombe County:

- 4 a. Precinct Asheville 4 in TIGER is shown as Precincts Asheville
5 4 and Asheville 28.
6 b. Precinct Asheville 22 in TIGER is shown as Precincts Asheville
7 22 and Asheville 27.
8 c. Precinct Asheville 19 in TIGER is shown as Precincts Asheville
9 19 and Asheville 29.
10 d. Precinct Riceville Swannanoa 2 CRU in TIGER is shown as
11 Precincts Riceville Swannanoa 2 CRU and Riceville
12 Swannanoa CRU 2.
13 e. Precinct Black Mountain 3 in TIGER is shown as Precincts
14 Black Mountain 3 and Black Mountain 4.

31 (8) Johnston County: Precinct East Clayton in TIGER is shown as
32 Precincts East Clayton and South Clayton.

- 34 a. Precinct Frank Porter Graham in TIGER is renamed Precinct
35 Damascus 1.
36 b. Precinct Dogwood Acres in TIGER is shown as Precincts
37 Dogwood Acres and Damascus 2.

38 (10) Rowan County:

- 39 a. Precinct Bostian Crossroads in TIGER is shown as Precincts
40 Bostian Crossroads and Rock Grove.
41 b. Precinct Enochville in TIGER is shown as Precincts Enochville
42 and West Enochville.

1 (11) Wake County:

- 2 a. Precinct 01-32 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 01-32 and
3 01-49.
- 4 b. Precinct 07-06 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 07-06 and
5 07-11.
- 6 c. Precinct 10-01 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 10-01 and
7 10-04.
- 8 d. Precinct 10-02 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 10-02 and
9 10-03.
- 10 e. Precinct 01-43 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 01-43 and

- 12 f. Precinct 07-02 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 07-02 and
13 07-12.
- 14 g. Precinct 08-04 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 08-04 and
15 08-08.
- 16 h. Precinct 12-02 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 12-02 and
17 12-06.
- 18 i. Precinct 18-03 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 18-03 and
19 18-08.
- 20 j. Precinct 19-02 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 19-02 and
21 19-06.
- 22 k. Precinct 19-03 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 19-03 and
23 19-07.
- 24 l. Precinct 19-04 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 19-04 and
25 19-08.
- 26 m. Precinct 20-04 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 20-04 and
27 20-10.
- 28 n. Precinct 01-32 in TIGER is shown as Precincts 01-32 and
29 01-49.

30 (d) If any precinct boundary is changed, that change shall not change the
31 boundary of a senatorial district, which shall remain the same.

32 (e) If this section does not specifically assign any area within North Carolina to a
33 district, and the area is:

- 34 (1) Entirely surrounded by a single district, the area shall be deemed to
35 have been assigned to that district.
- 36 (2) Contiguous to two or more districts, the area shall be deemed to have
37 been assigned to that district which contains the least population
38 according to the 2000 United States Census.
- 39 (3) Contiguous to only one district and to another state or the Atlantic
40 Ocean, the area shall be deemed to have been assigned to that district."

41 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
