2	AN ACT TO REMOVE THE SUNSET ON THE ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF CENT
3	STATE SALES AND USE TAX AND TO REDUCE THE COUNTY SHARE OF

5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. Section 34.13(c) of S.L. 2001-424 reads as rewritten:
7	"SECTION 34.13.(c) This section becomes effective October 16, 2001, and applies
8	to sales made on or after that date. This section is repealed effective for sales made on
9	or after July 1, 2003. This section does not affect the rights or liabilities of the State, a
10	taxpayer, or another person arising under a statute amended or repealed by this section
11	before the effective date of its amendment or repeal; nor does it affect the right to any
12	refund or credit of a tax that accrued under the amended or repealed statute before the
13	effective date of its amendment or repeal."
14	SECTION 2.(a) Article 5 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended
15	by adding a new section to read:
16	"§ 105-164.44G. Transfer to the Department of Health and Human Services for
17	Medicaid.
18	At the end of each quarter, the Secretary must transfer to the Department of Health
19	and Human Services an amount equal to the estimated amount of tax proceeds
20	generated by one-half cent $(1/2\phi)$ of the general State sales and use tax during that
21	quarter. The Department of Health and Human Services shall use funds transferred
22	under this section to reduce the county share of the nonfederal share of medical
23	assistance payments. To the extent that funds transferred under this section exceed the
24	county share of the nonfederal share of medical assistance payments, the Department of
25	Health and Human Services shall use these funds for the State share of the nonfederal
26	share of medical assistance payments."
27	SECTION 2.(b) G.S. 108A-87 is amended by adding a new subsection to
28	read:

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GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA

"(a1) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, the county
share of the nonfederal share of medical assistance payments shall not exceed fifteen
percent (15%) of the total nonfederal share of medical assistance payments. The county
share of medical assistance payments shall be further reduced by the funds transferred
to the Department of Health and Human Services under G.S. 105-164.44G."
SECTION 2.(c) This section becomes effective July 1, 2003.
SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act is effective
