A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO GRANT ARREST POWERS TO THE TOWN OF ROWLAND IN  
2 CERTAIN AREAS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding:

- 6 (1) The one-mile limitation of G.S. 160A-286, the Town of Rowland may  
7 also exercise the powers granted by that section; and  
8 (2) The one-mile jurisdiction of G.S. 15A-402(c), law enforcement  
9 officers of the Town of Rowland may arrest persons,

10 in the following described territory:

11 North Carolina State Highway 130: BEGINNING at the southeastern limits  
12 of the Town of Rowland and including all of the right-of-way of North Carolina State  
13 Highway 130 from the town limits in a southeasterly direction approximately 1.0 mile  
14 to the line perpendicular to the right-of-way of North Carolina State Highway 130  
15 which includes the intersection of the northeastern right-of-way of North Carolina State  
16 Highway 130 and the southeastern right-of-way of Iona Church Road; thence from  
17 northeastern right-of-way of North Carolina State Highway 130 and including all of the  
18 right-of-way of Iona Church Road in a northeasterly direction 300 feet.

19 Interstate 95: Beginning at the northeastern right-of-way of North Carolina  
20 State Highway 130 and including all of the right-of-way of I-95 approximately 2.4 miles  
21 in a southwesterly direction to the South Carolina State Line.

22 Interstate 95 Ramps: All of the rights-of-way for exit and entrance ramps for  
23 Interstate 95 just north of the South Carolina State Line and at North Carolina State  
24 Highway 130.

25 United States Highways 301 and 501: Beginning at the South Carolina State  
26 Line and including all of the right-of-way of United States Highways 301 and 501 (a  
27 combined right-of-way) in a northerly direction approximately 2.1 miles to the  
28 southeastern limits of the Town of Rowland.

29 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
