The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten:	
"(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax Cities and towns may levy a tax	of not
more than five dollars (\$5.00) thirty dollars (\$30.00) per year upon any vehicle i	esident
in the city or town. The proceeds of the tax may be used for any lawful purpose."	
SECTION 2. Chapter 31 of the 1991 Session Laws is repealed.	
SECTION 3. This act applies to the City of Greensboro only.	
SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
