2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CHILD MEDICAL EVALUATION
3	PROGRAM.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
6	Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one hundred ninety-five thousand
7	dollars (\$195,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred
8	ninety-five thousand dollars (\$395,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year. These funds
9	shall be used for the Child Medical Evaluation Program to provide for the following:
10	(1) Increased reimbursement for exams from \$75.00/case to \$150.00/case.
11	(2) A colposcopy diagnostic fee.
12	(3) Additional hours and increased hourly mental health reimbursement.
13	(4) Increased support and consultation to local providers.
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
