1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR LOW-WEALTH  
3 SCHOOL SYSTEMS.  
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to  
6 Local School Administrative Units the sum of forty-three million dollars (\$43,000,000)  
7 for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of forty-three million dollars (\$43,000,000)  
8 for the 2002-2003 fiscal year for low-wealth school systems' supplemental funding.  
9 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
