A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
SERVICES TO CHARGE INTEREST FOR PAST-DUE ACCOUNTS
RECEIVABLE OWED TO THE OFFICE BY STATE AGENCIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 3D of Chapter 147 of the General Statutes is amended
by adding a new section to read:

"§ 147-33.93. Fees; interest.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Office of Information Technology
Services may charge interest against any State government agency, at the rate
established pursuant to G.S. 105-241.1(i), on past-due accounts receivable from the date
the receivable was due until it is paid."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
