The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 1997-103 reads as rewritten:	
"Section 1. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill, with a firearm or	other deadly
weapon, or to attempt to hunt, take, or kill, with a firearm or other deadly	weapon, any
wild animal or wild bird hunt with a loaded firearm, including center	er-fire rifles,
shotguns, or pistols with barrel lengths greater than five and one-half inches	s on, from, or
across the right-of-way of any public road, street, highway, or thoro	ughfare. For
purposes of this section, "loaded firearm" means a firearm with shells in	the chamber,
magazine, or clip.	
It is prima facie evidence of a violation of this section to possess a lo	aded firearm
outside of a vehicle on the roadway or right-of-way of a public road."	
SECTION 2. This act applies only to Harnett County.	
SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2002.
