A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO GRANT ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY WITH REGARD TO THE  
2 PURCHASE OF TEXTBOOKS TO THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG  
3 SCHOOLS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 3 of Article 8 of  
7 Chapter 115C of the General Statutes or any other provision of law, the  
8 Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local School Administrative Unit may purchase textbooks on  
9 the State-adopted list without using the State textbook distribution system or the  
10 textbook warehouse facility operated by the State Board of Education.

11 **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local  
12 School Administrative Unit.

13 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.
