MANAGEMENT COMMISSION PROJECT CERTIFICATION.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to complete the planning for the Information Technology Expansion Project and the Information Resource Management Commission (IRMC) Project Certification. The Department shall not expend any additional funds for information technology expansion prior to review of the IRMC Project Certification by the Joint Select Committee on Information Technology. The results of the IRMC Project Certification should be presented to the Joint Select Committee on Information Technology no later than December 31, 2001.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
