A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF
ESTABLISHING A STATE MILITARY MUSEUM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Department of Cultural Resources shall study the feasibility of establishing a State Military Museum. The Department shall report its findings, including any recommendations, to the General Assembly no later than February 1, 2002.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to study the feasibility of establishing a State Military Museum.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
