SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year for diabetes prevention and control. These funds may be used for community-based diabetes awareness and education programs, coalition-building, outreach for early detection and intervention, enhanced provider training in the prevention and self-management of diabetes and its health consequences, and a strengthened focus on minority populations experiencing disparities in the burden of diabetes.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
