**H 257. UNAUTHORIZED USE OF CB EQUIPMENT. TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF CB RADIO EQUIPMENT IN A MANNER NOT AUTHORIZED BY THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION.** Adds new GS 62-322.1 making it a Class 3 misdemeanor to use CB radio equipment (as defined in federal regulations) in a manner not authorized by the Federal Communications Comm'n. Effective when it becomes law and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.

**H 257. UNAUTHORIZED USE OF CB EQUIPMENT.** Intro. 3/6/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition: (1) changes section number of new section to GS 62-328 (was, GS 62-322.1); (2) defines "Citizens Band radio equipment" to be Citizen Band radio equipment authorized by the FCC; (3) adds more specific references to federal regulations prohibiting the use of power amplifiers or equipment; and (4) makes law inapplicable to any licensee that is exempted under 47 U.S.C. 302a(f)(2). Makes act effective Dec. 1, 2003 (was, when it became law)

**H 257. UNAUTHORIZED USE OF CB EQUIPMENT.** Intro. 3/6/03. House amendment makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Amends GS 62-328(d) to provide that violation must be willful and knowing to be punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor.
