H 786. CIVIL PARKING/RED LIGHT PRIMA FACIE RULE. *TO PROVIDE THAT THE PRIMA FACIE RULE FOR PARKING APPLIES TO CIVIL PARKING AND RED LIGHT CAMERA ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS.* Amends GS 20-162.1 to clarify that prima facie rule applies to evidence presented in civil nonjudicial proceedings. Amends GS 160A-300.1(c) to provide that where traffic infraction was recorded by traffic control photographic system, an owner who leased or rented the vehicle to another person or company and receives notice of the infraction within 90 days will be excused from infraction if owner provides affidavit including name and address of lessee within thirty days of receiving notice. If notice of violation is not received within 90 days, owner shall not be held responsible for violation.

H 786. CIVIL PARKING/RED LIGHT PRIMA FACIE RULE. Intro. 3/27/03. House amendment makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 160A-300.1(c)(1) to add the following to the information that owner of vehicle must furnish to avoid responsibility for citation: statement that the person who received citation is not owner or driver of vehicle or was not driving vehicle at time and location designated in citation.

H 786. PARKING/RED LIGHT CAMERA LIABILITY RULES (NEW). Intro. 3/27/03. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Deletes amendment to GS 20-162.1. Adds subsection to GS 160A-301 (which permits cities to regulate parking) providing that owner of leased or rented vehicle not liable for violation if owner gives city affidavit giving name and address of lessee or renter. Makes technical changes to proposed amendment to GS 160A-300.1.

H 786. PARKING/RED LIGHT/SPEED CAMERA LIAB. RULES. Intro. 3/27/03. Conference report recommends the following changes to 3rd edition to reconcile matters in controversy. The report continues the provisions in the Senate committee substitute and adds comparable provisions to uncodified local acts permitting red light cameras and cameras to detect speeding.

SL 2003-380 (H 786). PARKING/RED LIGHT CAMERA LIABILITY RULES. AN ACT TO AMEND LIABILITY RULES THAT APPLY TO CIVIL PARKING, RED LIGHT CAMERA, AND PHOTOGRAPHIC SPEED-MEASURING SYSTEM ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS. Summarized in *Daily Bulletin* 3/27/03, 4/24/03, 6/4/03, and 7/17/03. Enacted August 1, 2003. Effective August 1, 2003. Section 5 expires June 30, 2006.
