BUTNER ADVISORY COUNCIL. *TO REVISE A STATUTE TO CREATE A BUTNER ADVISORY COUNCIL SO AS TO ELECT ALL MEMBERS AT LARGE IN ONE MULTISEAT RACE AND ELIMINATE STAGGERED TERMS; TO DEFINE THE ELECTORAL JURISDICTION OF THE COUNCIL; AND TO AMEND THE LEGISLATION IN OTHER NEEDED WAYS.* In addition to amending GS 122C-413 as title indicates, requires the Dep't of Health and Human Services to reimburse the Granville County Board of Elections for the actual cost of administering the election of the Butner Advisory Council.

H 1074. BUTNER ADVISORY COUNCIL. Intro. 4/10/03. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Amends GS 122C-413(a) and (b) to establish the jurisdiction of the Butner Advisory Council as is shown on a map produced May 20, 2003 (was, April 3, 2003). Adds new GS 122C-413(a1) authorizing any Butner resident who is also a resident of Durham County to vote in any Butner election as if voter were a Granville County resident, and requiring that Durham County Board of Elections send the Granville County Board of Elections any information necessary to conduct election. Amends GS 122C-413(c) to establish filing fee of \$10.00 for first election of Butner Advisory Council and adds new GS 122C-413(d1) to provide that reimbursement for Council election shall not come from General Fund. Adds new GS 122C-413(g) limiting the authority of the Council over the Lyons Station Sanitary District. Amends GS 122C-408(a) to redefine the territorial jurisdiction of officers employed by the Sec'y of Crime Control and Public Safety as the territory shown on May 20, 2003, map. Makes technical and conforming changes.

Adds to title *CORRECT THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE NASH-ROCKY MOUNT SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT AND THE EDGECOMBE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM* and amends bill as title indicates. Describes new boundary line.
