A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT MAKING VOID AND UNENFORCEABLE AS A MATTER OF PUBLIC
2 POLICY ANY PROVISION IN ANY AGREEMENT OR CONTRACT THAT
3 PROHIBITS THE REUSING, REMANUFACTURING, OR REFILLING OF A
4 TONER OR INKJET CARTRIDGE.
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6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 75 of the General Statutes is amended by
8 adding a new section to read:

9 "**§ 75-36. Certain contracts relating to toner or inkjet cartridges void and**
10 **unenforceable as a matter of public policy.**

11 Any provision in any agreement or contract that prohibits the reusing,
12 remanufacturing, or refilling of a toner or inkjet cartridge is void and unenforceable as a
13 matter of public policy."

14 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
