AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY FIRE SAFETY IN LOCAL CONFINEMENT FACILITIES. The Canadal Assembly of North Carolina anada:
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study the issue of
fire safety in local confinement facilities and consider whether the current process for
inspecting those facilities is sufficient to ensure that those facilities are in compliance
with all applicable State and local laws and regulations related to fire safety for existing
facilities, including the provisions of the National Fire Protection Code 101 (1991
Edition) applicable to existing detention facilities, the North Carolina State Building
Code in force at the time the facility was constructed, modified, or renovated, the current North Carolina Fire Prevention Code, and the requirements set forth in
Subchapter 10-3J of the North Carolina Administrative Code.
SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission shall report its findings
and any recommendations to the 2004 Regular Session of the 2003 General Assembly.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
