Short Title: Consolidate Administrative Functions. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE
2 FUNCTIONS WITHIN STATE GOVERNMENT, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
3 GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION TO PROMOTE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY
4 AND SAVINGS ON STATE SPENDING.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** The Governor's Commission to Promote Government
8 Efficiency and Savings on State Spending has recommended that administrative and
9 support functions of State government be consolidated in areas of high concentration of
10 State facilities, modeled after similar measures taken recently for State facilities in the
11 Morganton area. To that end, The University of North Carolina (through the Office of
12 the President), the Judicial Branch (through the Administrative Office of the Courts),
13 the Executive Branch (through the Department of Administration), the Legislative
14 Branch (through the Legislative Services Office), the Community College System
15 (through the President's Office), and the Department of Public Instruction shall develop
16 a plan to consolidate administrative functions in areas of high concentrations of State
17 facilities. That plan shall be presented to the General Assembly no later than May 1,
18 2004.

19 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
