5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-301 is amended by adding a new subsection to
7	read:
8	"(c1) Kindergarten Class Size. – Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
9	kindergarten class shall not exceed 15 students. If a local board of education cannot
10	organizationally correct an exception to this limit and the exception resulted from (i)
11	exceptional circumstances, emergencies, or acts of God, (ii) large changes in student
12	population, or (iii) organizational problems caused by remote geographic location, the
13	local board of education shall apply for an allotment adjustment as provided in
14	subsection (g) of this section. If the local board of education does not receive an
15	allotment adjustment, a full-time teacher assistant shall be assigned to the classroom.
16	This subsection shall not be subject to waiver."
17	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
