The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 58-36-65 is amended by adding a new subsection	on to read:
"(n) The subclassification plan shall provide that the comprehensive	
deductible shall not apply to motor vehicle windshield glass. The deductible	provisions
of any policy of motor vehicle insurance for either comprehensive property	damage or
any combined additional insurance delivered or issued in this State by	-
authorized to write motor vehicle insurance in this State shall not be app	plicable to
damage to the windshield of any motor vehicle covered under that policy."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
