5	SEC'	TION 1.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
6	Department of	Health and Human Services the sum of one hundred fifty thousand
7	dollars (\$150,0	00) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty
8		s (\$150,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to
9	implement the f	following recommendations of the Osteoporosis Prevention Task Force:
10	(1)	Increase public awareness and education about osteoporosis, its
11		impact, the importance of early diagnosis and appropriate
12		management, and effective prevention strategies.
13	(2)	Increase osteoporosis education and outreach to diverse population
14		groups in North Carolina.
15	(3)	Increase health and human services professionals' understanding of
16		osteoporosis, its impact, and the importance and skill required for early
17		diagnosis, appropriate management, and effective treatment strategies.
18	(4)	Provide access to knowledge on the prevalence, diagnosis, treatment,
19		and prevention of osteoporosis.
20	(5)	Improve the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention abilities of health and
21		human services professionals.
22	(6)	Reduce barriers to diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of osteoporosis
