1	A HOUSE RESOLUTION COMMENDING BILLY GRAHAM, RENOWNED
2	HUMANITARIAN, PHILANTHROPIST, AND GREAT NORTH CAROLINIAN.
3	Whereas, there have been many great North Carolinians, but few have
4	impacted the world more than Billy Graham; and
5	Whereas, Billy Graham was born William Franklin Graham, Jr. to William
6	Franklin Graham and Morrow Coffey Graham on a dairy farm in Charlotte; and
7	Whereas, Billy Graham was ordained to the ministry in 1939 and thereafter
8	served as pastor of the First Baptist Church in Western Springs, Illinois, from 1943 to
9	1945, as a member of Youth for Christ International, where he ministered to young
10	people and military personnel, from 1945 to 1950, and as President of Northwestern
11	Schools, a liberal arts college, Bible school, and theological seminary, from 1947 to
12	1952; and
13	Whereas, after World War II, Billy Graham attained international prominence
14	through a series of crusades that began in 1949; and
15	Whereas, since 1950, Billy Graham has conducted his ministry by means of a
16	weekly radio program, "Hour of Decision"; a newspaper column, "My Answer";
17	televised crusades; articles published in "Decision" magazine; and films produced and
18	distributed by World Wide Pictures; and
19	Whereas, over the years, Billy Graham has preached to live audiences of over
20	210 million people in more than 185 countries and territories; and
21	Whereas, a renowned humanitarian and philanthropist, Billy Graham has
22	tried to help those in need through his work with the World Emergency Relief Fund,
23	which gives financial assistance to disaster victims, and the BGEA Love in Action
24	committees, which collect and distribute food and clothing internationally; and
25	Whereas, Billy Graham has received numerous awards and honorary degrees,
26	including the Congressional Gold Medal in 1996, the North Carolina Award for Public
27	Service in 1986, and the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1983; and

1	Whereas, Billy Graham received the Big Brother of the Year Award in 1966
2	for his work on behalf of the welfare of children and the Ronald Reagan Presidential
3	Foundation Freedom Award in 2000 for monumental and lasting contributions to the
4	cause of freedom; and
5	Whereas, Billy Graham was cited by the George Washington Carver
6	Memorial Institute for his contributions to race relations in 1964 and was recognized by
7	the Anti-Defamation League of the B'nai B'rith and the National Conference of
8	Christians and Jews for his efforts to foster a better understanding among all faiths; and
9	Whereas, Billy Graham has counseled and advised presidents and world
10	leaders and has participated in many historic occasions, such as the tearing down of the
11	Berlin Wall; and
12	Whereas, Billy Graham has opposed racial discrimination and, in the 1950s
13	and 1960s, never held a segregated meeting but conducted fully integrated crusades; and
14	Whereas, Billy Graham has written 18 books, all of which have become best
15	sellers, including his latest book, "Just As I Am," an autobiography published in 1997;

17	Whereas, Billy Graham has been named one of Gallup Poll's list of the "Ten
18	Most Admired Men in the World" for an unprecedented 43 times, 36 of which have
19	been in consecutive years; and
20	Whereas, Billy Graham continues to inspire the world with his good works;
21	and
22	Whereas, Billy Graham is proud to call himself a Tar Heel and to make North
23	Carolina his home; and
24	Whereas, Governor Michael F. Easley issued a proclamation on October 29,
25	2002, during the official groundbreaking ceremony for the Billy Graham Association
26	corporate headquarters in the City of Charlotte honoring Billy Graham and commending
27	him for his many accomplishments; Now, therefore,
28	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:
29	SECTION 1. The North Carolina House of Representatives commends Billy
30	Graham, renowned humanitarian, philanthropist, and great North Carolinian, for all of
31	his good works and his many accomplishments.
32	SECTION 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this
33	resolution to Billy Graham.
34	SECTION 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
