A HOUSE RESOLUTION COMMENDING BILLY GRAHAM. RENOWNED 1 2 HUMANITARIAN, PHILANTHROPIST, AND GREAT NORTH CAROLINIAN. 3 Whereas, there have been many great North Carolinians, but few have impacted the world more than Billy Graham; and 4 Whereas, Billy Graham was born William Franklin Graham, Jr. to William 5 Franklin Graham and Morrow Coffey Graham on a dairy farm in Charlotte; and 6 Whereas, Billy Graham was ordained to the ministry in 1939 and thereafter 7 8 served as pastor of the First Baptist Church in Western Springs, Illinois, from 1943 to 1945, as a member of Youth for Christ International, where he ministered to young 9 people and military personnel, from 1945 to 1950, and as President of Northwestern 10 Schools, a liberal arts college, Bible school, and theological seminary, from 1947 to 11 12 1952; and Whereas, after World War II, Billy Graham attained international prominence 13 14 through a series of crusades that began in 1949; and Whereas, since 1950, Billy Graham has conducted his ministry by means of a 15 16 weekly radio program, "Hour of Decision"; a newspaper column, "My Answer"; televised crusades; articles published in "Decision" magazine; and films produced and 17 distributed by World Wide Pictures; and 18 19 Whereas, over the years, Billy Graham has preached to live audiences of over 20 210 million people in more than 185 countries and territories; and
