A HOUSE RESOLUTION COMMENDING BILLY GRAHAM, RENOWNED 1 2 HUMANITARIAN, PHILANTHROPIST, AND GREAT NORTH CAROLINIAN. 3 Whereas, there have been many great North Carolinians, but few have 4 impacted the world more than Billy Graham; and Whereas, Billy Graham was born William Franklin Graham, Jr. to William 5 Franklin Graham and Morrow Coffey Graham on a dairy farm in Charlotte; and 6 Whereas, Billy Graham was ordained to the ministry in 1939 and thereafter 7 8 served as pastor of the First Baptist Church in Western Springs, Illinois, from 1943 to 1945, as a member of Youth for Christ International, where he ministered to young 9 10 people and military personnel, from 1945 to 1950, and as President of Northwestern Schools, a liberal arts college, Bible school, and theological seminary, from 1947 to 11 1952; and 12 13 Whereas, after World War II, Billy Graham attained international prominence 14 through a series of crusades that began in 1949; and Whereas, since 1950, Billy Graham has conducted his ministry by means of a 15 weekly radio program, "Hour of Decision"; a newspaper column, "My Answer"; 16 televised crusades; articles published in "Decision" magazine; and films produced and 17 distributed by World Wide Pictures; and 18 19 Whereas, over the years, Billy Graham has preached to live audiences of over 210 million people in more than 185 countries and territories; and 20 Whereas, a renowned humanitarian and philanthropist, Billy Graham has 21 tried to help those in need through his work with the World Emergency Relief Fund, 22

which gives financial assistance to disaster victims, and the BGEA Love in Action 1 2 committees, which collect and distribute food and clothing internationally; and 3 Whereas, Billy Graham has received numerous awards and honorary degrees, 4 including the Congressional Gold Medal in 1996, the North Carolina Award for Public 5 Service in 1986, and the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1983; and Whereas, Billy Graham received the Big Brother of the Year Award in 1966 6 7 for his work on behalf of the welfare of children and the Ronald Reagan Presidential 8 Foundation Freedom Award in 2000 for monumental and lasting contributions to the 9 cause of freedom; and 10 Whereas, Billy Graham was cited by the George Washington Carver Memorial Institute for his contributions to race relations in 1964 and was recognized by 11 12 the Anti-Defamation League of the B'nai B'rith and the National Conference of 13 Christians and Jews for his efforts to foster a better understanding among all faiths; and 14 Whereas, Billy Graham has counseled and advised presidents and world 15 leaders and has participated in many historic occasions, such as the tearing down of the 16 Berlin Wall: and 17 Whereas, Billy Graham has opposed racial discrimination and, in the 1950s 18 and 1960s, never held a segregated meeting but conducted fully integrated crusades; and 19 Whereas, Billy Graham has written 18 books, all of which have become best 20 sellers, including his latest book, "Just As I Am," an autobiography published in 1997; 21 and 22 Whereas, Billy Graham has been named one of Gallup Poll's list of the "Ten 23 Most Admired Men in the World" for an unprecedented 43 times, 36 of which have 24 been in consecutive years; and 25 Whereas, Billy Graham continues to inspire the world with his good works; 26 and 27 Whereas, Billy Graham is proud to call himself a Tar Heel and to make North Carolina his home; and 28 29 Whereas, Governor Michael F. Easley issued a proclamation on October 29, 30 2002, during the official groundbreaking ceremony for the Billy Graham Association corporate headquarters in the City of Charlotte honoring Billy Graham and commending 31 32 him for his many accomplishments; Now, therefore, 33 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives: 34 **SECTION 1.** The North Carolina House of Representatives commends Billy 35 Graham, renowned humanitarian, philanthropist, and great North Carolinian, for all of his good works and his many accomplishments. 36 37 **SECTION 2.** The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this 38 resolution to Billy Graham. 39 **SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
