1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE COMBINATION OF THE
2 BURLINGTON STATISTICAL AREA WITH THE GREENSBORO/HIGH POINT
3 STATISTICAL AREA.

4 Whereas, the City of Burlington and Alamance County were designated part
5 of the Greensboro/Winston-Salem/High Point Metropolitan Statistical Area in 1990;
6 and

7 Whereas, the City of Burlington's corporate limits extend into Guilford
8 County; and

9 Whereas, the current combined designation does not include the City of
10 Burlington and Alamance County within the Greensboro/Winston-Salem/High Point
11 Combined Statistical Area; and

12 Whereas, the current regulations set forth by the Office of Management and
13 Budget allow for the combination of the Burlington Metropolitan Statistical Area with
14 the Greensboro/High Point Metropolitan Statistical Area; Now, therefore,

15 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

16 **SECTION 1.** The Office of Management and Budget is requested to
17 combine the Burlington Metropolitan Statistical Area with the Greensboro/High Point
18 Metropolitan Statistical Area.

19 **SECTION 2.** The Principal Clerk of the House of Representatives shall send
20 a copy of this resolution to the Office of Management and Budget and the North
21 Carolina Congressional delegation.

22 **SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
