A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PROVIDE A FOUR-YEAR TERM FOR THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN
OF CHADBOURN.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2.3 of the Charter of the Town of Chadbourn, being Chapter 895, Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2.3. Mayor; Term of Office; Duties. The In 2003 and quadrennially thereafter, the Mayor shall be elected by all the qualified voters of the Town for a term of two four years or until his or her successor is elected and qualified; shall be the official head of the Town government and preside at meetings of the Council; shall have the right to vote only when there is an equal division on any question or matter before the Council; and shall exercise the powers and duties conferred by law or as directed by the Council."

**SECTION 2.** Section 3.3 of the Charter of the Town of Chadbourn, being Chapter 895, Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3.3. Election of Mayor. A Mayor shall be elected in <u>each\_a</u> regular municipal election."

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective beginning with the Mayor elected in the 2003 municipal election.
