SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred eighty-seven thousand dollars (\$187,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for supported employment for the TEACCH Supported Program at the School of Medicine of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
