A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SENIOR CENTER DEVELOPMENT
AND OUTREACH, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA
STUDY COMMISSION ON AGING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the sum of two hundred
eighty-one thousand dollars (\$281,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year for senior center
outreach and development. State funds shall not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of
reimbursable costs.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
