Referred to: Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House. May 12, 2004 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE I-40 CORRIDOR IN NORTH CAROLINA AS THE U.S. VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 2 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 136-18.5B. U.S. Veterans Memorial Highway. The Interstate Highway 40 corridor in the State is designated as the 'U.S. Veterans Memorial Highway'. The Department shall erect signs along the corridor with a blue background and a United States flag decal, and shall include the phrase 'This is the' above the phrase 'U.S. Veterans Memorial Highway'." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
