1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AN INVESTIGATORIAL
3 ASSISTANT POSITION IN PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 16A.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-69 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 7A-69. Investigatorial assistants.**

7 The district attorney in prosecutorial districts 1, 3B, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15A,
8 15B, 16A, 18, 19B, 20, 21, 22, 24, 25, 26, 27A, 27B, 28, 29, and 30 is entitled to one
9 investigatorial assistant, and the district attorney in prosecutorial district 10 is entitled to
10 two investigatorial assistants, to be appointed by the district attorney and to serve at his
11 pleasure.

12 It shall be the duty of the investigatorial assistant to investigate cases preparatory to
13 trial and to perform such other Duties as may be assigned by the district attorney. The
14 investigatorial assistant is entitled to reimbursement for his subsistence and travel
15 expenses to the same extent as State employees generally."

16 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
17 Department the sum of fifty-nine thousand twenty-two dollars (\$59,022) for the
18 2004-2005 fiscal year to establish an investigatorial assistant position in Prosecutorial
19 District 16A.

20 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
