May 13, 2004 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT REQUIRING JOB DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT GRANT (JDIG) PROGRAM AGREEMENTS TO CONTAIN A PROVISION ENCOURAGING THE USE OF SMALL BUSINESSES HEADQUARTERED IN NORTH CAROLINA. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 143B-437.57(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(a) Terms. – Each community economic development agreement shall include at least the following: A provision encouraging the business to contract with small businesses (25)headquartered in the State for goods and services." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to
