6	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-68(a) reads as rewritten:		
7	"(a) In	the event any registration card or registration plate is lost, mutil	lated, or
8	becomes illegible, the owner or legal representative of the owner of the vehicle for		
9	which the same was issued, as shown by the records of the Division, shall immediately		
10	make applica	ation for and may obtain a duplicate or a substitute or a new reg	istration
11	under a new	registration number, as determined to be most advisable by the I	Division,
12	upon the app	plicant's furnishing under oath information satisfactory to the Divis	sion and
13	payment of	required fee. If a registration plate is stolen and the applicant f	urnishes
14	sworn inform	nation about the theft that is satisfactory to the Division, the reg	<u>istration</u>
15	plate shall be	e replaced by the Division without a fee being paid."	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
