The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifty thousand dollars
(\$50,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to provide office and clinic space for the
Charlotte TEACCH Center, a regional treatment and diagnostic program for children
and adults with autism and their families, under the supervision of Division TEACCH at
the School of Medicine of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
