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2	AN ACT TO C	LARIFY THE DUTIES OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON
3	JUVENILE	JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION, AS
4	RECOMME	NDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE CORRECTIONS, CRIME
5	CONTROL,	AND JUVENILE JUSTICE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 143B-557 reads as rewritten:	
8	"§ 143B-557. P	owers and duties of the Council.
9	The State Co	ouncil shall have the following powers and duties:
10	(1)	Advise the Department in the review of the State's juvenile justice
11		planning, the development of the community juvenile justice
12		councils, planning and the development of a formula for the
13		distribution of funds to the Juvenile Crime Prevention Councils.
14	(2)	Advise all State agencies serving juveniles for the purpose of
15		developing a consistent philosophy with regard to providing services
16		to juveniles and promoting collaboration and the efficient and effective
17		delivery of services to juveniles and families through State, local, and
18		district programs and fully address problems of collaboration across
19		State agencies with the goal of serving juveniles.
20	(3)	Review and comment on juvenile justice, delinquency prevention, and
21		juvenile services grant applications prepared for submission under any
22		federal grant program by any governmental entity of the State.
23	(4)	Review the juvenile justice system's operation and prioritization of
24		funding needs.
25	(5)	Review the progress and accomplishment of State and local juvenile
26		justice, delinquency prevention, and juvenile services projects.
27	(6)	Develop recommendations concerning the establishment of priorities
28		and needed improvements with respect to juvenile justice, delinquency

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1	prevention, and juvenile services and report its recommendations to
2	the General Assembly on or before March 1 each year.
3	(7) Review and comment on the proposed budget for the Department."
4	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
