33 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, every sworn law-enforcement "(a) 34 officer as defined by G.S. 135-1(11b) or G.S. 143-166.30(a)(4) employed by a State 35 department, agency, or institution who qualifies under this section shall receive, beginning on the last day of the month in which he retires on a basic service retirement 36 under the provisions of G.S. 135-5(a) or G.S. 143-166(y), an annual separation 37 38 allowance equal to eighty-five hundredths percent (0.85%) of the annual equivalent of 39 the base rate of compensation most recently applicable to him for each year of 40 creditable service. The allowance shall be paid in 12 equal installments on the last day 41 of each month. To qualify for the allowance the officer shall:
