2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT AN AGGRAVATING FACTOR TO MANUFACTURE
3 METHAMPHETAMINE IN A LOCATION THAT ENDANGERS A CHILD AS
4 RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE CORRECTIONS, CRIME
5 CONTROL, AND JUVENILE JUSTICE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 15A-1340.16(d) is amended by adding a new subdivision
8 to read:

9 "(16a) The offense is the manufacture of methamphetamine and was
10 committed where a person under the age of 18 lives, was present, or
11 was otherwise endangered by-exposure to the drug, its ingredients, its
12 by-products, or its waste."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2004, and applies to
14 offenses committed on or after that date.
