May 20, 2004 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE EXCISE TAX ON CIGARETTES AS 3 RECOMMENDED BY THE LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON 4 CHILDREN AND YOUTH AND TO MAKE OTHER **TECHNICAL** 5 CORRECTIONS. Whereas, tobacco use continues to be a major health concern among youth in 6 7 this State: and 8 Whereas, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, 9 raising the price of a pack of cigarettes, through a tax, is the most effective way to prevent youth from smoking; and 10 Whereas, North Carolina's cigarette tax is the second lowest in the nation; 11 12 Now, therefore. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 13 SECTION 1. G.S. 105-113.5 reads as rewritten: 14 15 "§ 105-113.5. Tax on cigarettes. 16 A tax is levied on the sale or possession for sale in this State, by a distributor, of all cigarettes at the rate of two and one-half mills-three and three-quarter cents (3.75φ) per 17 individual cigarette. 18 19 This tax does not apply to any of the following: 20 Sample cigarettes distributed without charge in packages containing (1)21 five or fewer cigarettes. 22 (2)Cigarettes in a package of cigarettes given without charge by the manufacturer of the cigarettes to an employee of the manufacturer who 23 works in a factory where cigarettes are made, if the cigarettes are not 24 taxed by the federal government." 25 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004. 26

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
