SECTION 1. G.S. 74F-18(b) reads as rewritten:

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 74F-18(b) reads as rewritten: "(b) All applicants for licensure or apprentice designation shall consent to a criminal history record check. Refusal to consent to a criminal history record check may constitute grounds for the Board to deny licensure or apprentice designation to an

constitute grounds for the Board to deny licensure or apprentice designation to an 9 10 applicant. The Board shall ensure that the State and national criminal history of an 11 applicant is checked. The Board shall be responsible for providing to the North Carolina Department of Justice the fingerprints of the applicant to be checked, a form signed by 12 13 the applicant consenting to the criminal record check and the use of fingerprints and 14 other identifying information required by the State or National Repositories of Criminal Histories, and any additional information required by the Department of Justice. The 15 16 Board shall keep all information obtained pursuant to this section confidential. The 17 Department of Justice may charge each applicant a fee for conducting the checks of criminal history records authorized by this subsection." 18

19 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
