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| 2 | AN ACT TO PHASE OUT THE COUNTY SHARE OF THE NONFEDERAL SHARE |
| 3 | OF MEDICAID COSTS OVER A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD AND TO PROVIDE |
| 4 | IMMEDIATE RELIEF FOR TIER ONE COUNTIES. |
| 5 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the |
| 7 | nonfederal share of the Medical Assistance Program costs, excluding administrative |
| 8 | costs, paid by the counties shall be reduced as follows: |
| 9 | (1) Effective July 1, 2004, the county share of Medicaid costs paid by Tier |
| 10 | 1 counties shall be reduced by six percent (6%). |
| 11 | (2) Effective July 1, 2005, the county share of Medicaid costs paid by Tier |
| 12 | 1 counties shall be further reduced by three percent (3%). |
| 13 | (3) Effective July 1, 2005, the county share of Medicaid costs paid by all |
| 14 | counties other than Tier 1 counties shall be reduced by three percent |
| 15 | (3%) per year until July 1, 2009, when the county share for all |
| 16 | counties, including Tier 1 counties, shall be zero percent (0%) . |
| 17 | (4) Effective July 1, 2008, the county share of Medicaid costs paid by Tier |
| 18 | 1 counties shall be further reduced by three percent (3%) per year until |
| 19 | the Tier 1 county nonfederal share is zero percent (0%) . |
| 20 | Effective July 1, 2009, the total nonfederal share of the Medical Assistance Program, |
| 21 | excluding administrative costs, shall be borne by the State. |
| 22 | SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2009, G.S. 108A-54 reads as rewritten: |
| 23 | " § 108A-54. Authorization of Medical Assistance Program. |
| 24 | The Department is authorized and empowered to establish a Medical Assistance |
| 25 | Program from federal, State and county federal and State appropriations and to adopt |
| 26 | rules and regulations under which payments are to be made in accordance with the |
| 27 | provisions of this Part. The nonfederal share may be divided between the State and the |

- counties, in a manner consistent with the provisions of the federal Social Security Act, 1
- except that the share required from the counties may not exceed the share required from 2
- 3 the state. If a portion of the nonfederal share is required from the counties, the boards of
- 4 county commissioners of the several counties shall levy, impose and collect the taxes
- 5 required for the special purpose of medical assistance as provided in this Part, in an
- 6 amount sufficient to cover each county's share of such assistance." 7
 - SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
