AN ACT PROVIDING TEN DAYS BONUS LEAVE TO THOSE STATE PERSONNEL WHO DID NOT RECEIVE SPECIAL ANNUAL BONUS LEAVE UNDER SECTION 30.12B OF S.L. 2003-284.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 2004, any person who is an assistant clerk of court, a deputy clerk of court, a magistrate, or a member of the Highway Patrol who is eligible to earn annual leave, and who did not receive special annual bonus leave under Section 30.12B of S.L. 2003-284, shall have a one-time additional 10 days of annual leave credited on that date. The additional leave shall be accounted for either separately or together with the leave provided by Section 28.3A of S.L. 2002-126. Part-time permanent employees shall receive a pro rata amount of the 10 days.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
