Short Title: Greensboro Vehicle Tax. (Local) Representatives Adams and Jones (Primary Sponsors). Sponsors: Referred to: Finance. March 6, 2003 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF GREENSBORO TO COLLECT A TAX ON MOTOR VEHICLES RESIDENT IN THE CITY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten: General Municipal Vehicle Tax. - Cities and towns may levy a tax of not "(b) more than five dollars (\$5.00)thirty dollars (\$30.00) per year upon any vehicle resident in the city or town. The proceeds of the tax may be used for any lawful purpose." **SECTION 2.** Chapter 31 of the 1991 Session Laws is repealed. **SECTION 3.** This act applies to the City of Greensboro only.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
