March 20, 2003 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO DEVELOP 3 AND ISSUE A SURVEYOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten: Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration 6 "(b) 7 plates: 8 9 (45b) Surveyor Plate. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the words 10 "Following In Their Footsteps" and shall bear a picture of a transit. 11 12 The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate. 13 14 (45b)(45c) Sweet Potato. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle. The plate may bear a phrase and picture representing the 15 16 State's official vegetable, the sweet potato. The Division may not issue 17 the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 18 applications for the plate. (45c)(45d) 19 Tobacco Heritage. - Issuable to the registered owner of a 20 motor vehicle. The plate shall bear a picture of a tobacco leaf and plow. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this 21 22 subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate." 23 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten: 24 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one 25 registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including 26 additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of 27 War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or 28
