5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 62A-8 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 62A-8. Payments from Fund.
8	(a) <u>Money–Fifty percent (50%) of the money</u> from the Emergency Telephone
9	System Fund shall be used only to pay for:
10	(1) The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone
11	equipment, including necessary computer hardware, software and
12	database provisioning, addressing, and nonrecurring costs of
13	establishing a 911 system, and
14	(2) The rates associated with the service supplier's 911 service and other
15	service supplier recurring charges.
16	(b) The following expenses are not eligible for payment from the Fund: Fifty
17	percent (50%) of the money from the Fund may be used for the following purposes: the
18	lease or purchase of real estate, cosmetic remodeling of emergency dispatch centers,
19	hiring, training, and compensating dispatchers, and the purchase of mobile
20	communications vehicles, ambulances, fire engines, or other emergency vehicles.
21	(c) A local government may contract with a service supplier for any term
22	negotiated by the service supplier and the local government and may make payments
23	from the Emergency Telephone System Fund to provide any payments required by the
24	contract."
25	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies to Halifax County only.
26	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
