The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 160A-286 reads as rewritten:	
"§ 160A-286. Extraterritorial jurisdiction of policemen.	
In addition to their authority within the corporate limits, city policemen shall have	
all the powers invested in law-enforcement officers by statute or common law within	
one mile-two miles of the corporate limits of the city, and on all property owner.	ed by or
leased to the city wherever located.	
Any officer pursuing an offender outside the corporate limits or extrate	erritorial
jurisdiction of the city shall be entitled to all of the privileges, immunities, and	benefits
to which he would be entitled if acting within the city, including coverage un	nder the
workers' compensation laws."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies to the City of Raleigh only.	
<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
