4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a	
6	new section to read:	
7	7 " <u>§ 14-362.4. Invisible fence pet containment system signage required.</u>	
8	(a) <u>A person who owns or rents property and restrains a dog on that property by</u>	
9	means of an invisible fence pet containment system shall post signage on the property	
10	indicating that the system has been installed there.	
11	(b) Any person who fails to post and maintain the signage required by subsection	
12	(a) of this section shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and shall be fined not more	
13	than fifty dollars (\$50.00)."	
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and applies to	
15	offenses committed on or after that date.	

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
