AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE POSTING OF SIGNS WHEN AN INVISIBLE FENCE

PET CONTAINMENT SYSTEM IS INSTALLED ON PROPERTY.
 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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**SECTION 1.** Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

## "§ 14-362.4. Invisible fence pet containment system signage required.

- (a) A person who owns or rents property and restrains a dog on that property by means of an invisible fence pet containment system shall post signage on the property indicating that the system has been installed there.
- (b) Any person who fails to post and maintain the signage required by subsection (a) of this section shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00)."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
