"§ 20-87. P	'assenger	vehicle	registration	fees.
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These shall be paid to the Division annually, as of the first day of January, for the registration and licensing of passenger vehicles, fees according to the following classifications and schedules:

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- (12) Private Motorcycles. The fee on private passenger motorcycles shall be fourteen dollars (\$14.00). When a motorcycle is equipped with an additional form of device designed to transport persons or property, the fee shall be twenty-one dollars (\$21.00). Five dollars (\$5.00) of the fees collected pursuant to this subdivision shall be used, in addition to any other funds appropriated for this purpose, to fund the Motorcycle Safety Instruction Program established pursuant to G.S. 115D-72."
- SECTION 4. This act becomes effective October 1, 2003.
