Short Title: Ocean Isle Beach Traffic Cameras.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF OCEAN ISLE BEACH TO USE
TRAFFIC CAMERAS TO MONITOR TRAFFIC ON PUBLIC STREETS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-300 reads as rewritten:

"§ 160A-300. **Traffic control.**

(a) A city may by ordinance prohibit, regulate, divert, control, and limit pedestrian or vehicular traffic upon the public streets, sidewalks, alleys, and bridges of the city.

(b) A city may expend public funds to place traffic cameras to monitor vehicular traffic on public streets."

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act applies to the Town of Ocean Isle Beach only.

SECTION 3. The Department of Transportation may allow the Town of Ocean Isle Beach to place a camera to monitor traffic on poles on or near the Ocean Isle Bridge.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
