SECTION 1. Chapter 113B of the General Statutes is amended by add	ing a
new Article to read:

"§ 113B-31. Implementation and administration.	
(a) The State Energy Office shall adopt rules implementing the pro	gram
established in G.S. 113B-30.	
(b) These rules shall be adopted after consultation with other State ager	ncies,
including the Departments of Transportation, Correction, Public Instruction, Rev	enue,
and Environment and Natural Resources, and interested organizations and business	es.
(c) These rules shall comply with environmental and energy regulations is	ssued
by the United States Department of Energy and the Environmental Protection Agen	cy.

(d) The rules shall provide that State and local government entities are not eligible for rebates or grants under the Alternative Fuel and Vehicle Rebate and Infrastructure Grant Program.

"§ 113B-32. Funding.

- (a) The program established pursuant to G.S. 113B-30 shall be funded by an increase in motor vehicle registration fees as provided in G.S. 20-87(b) and G.S. 20-88(i2).
- (b) The funds collected by the Division of Motor Vehicles shall be transferred quarterly to a special account in the Department of Administration for the State Energy Office to administer the program and provide the rebates and grants.
- (c) The State Energy Office and the Division of Motor Vehicles may use up to five percent (5%) of the funds collected under this section for the administration of the program.
- (d) The State Energy Office may use up to ten percent (10%) of the funds collected under this section for education and awareness about the applications and advantages of alternative fuels and vehicles.

"§ 113B-33. Alternative Fuel and Vehicle Rebate and Infrastructure Grant Program Fund established.

The Alternative Fuel and Vehicle Rebate and Infrastructure Grant Program Fund is created as a nonreverting account within the Department of Administration. All fees collected pursuant to this Article shall be credited to the Fund. The Fund shall be used for the purposes set out in this Article.

"§ 113B-34. Reports.

- (a) The Division of Motor Vehicles shall provide to the State Energy Office quarterly reports of all registered motor vehicles identified by fuel type.
- (b) The State Energy Office shall provide an annual report to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee on the expenditure of funds associated with the program established by G.S. 113B-30 and the number of alternative fuel vehicles registered in North Carolina."

SECTION 2. G.S. 20-87 reads as rewritten:

"§ 20-87. Passenger vehicle registration fees.

(a) These There shall be paid to the Division annually, as of the first day of January, for the registration and licensing of passenger vehicles, fees according to the following classifications and schedules:

. . .

- (b) Upon initial registration or renewal, an additional one-dollar (\$1.00) fee shall be paid to the Division in addition to the fees authorized by subsection (a) of this section to fund the Alternative Fuel and Vehicle Rebate and Infrastructure Grant Program established in G.S. 113B-30."
 - **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-88 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- "(i2) Upon initial registration or renewal, an additional one-dollar (\$1.00) fee shall be paid to the Division in addition to all other fees authorized by this section to fund the Alternative Fuel and Vehicle Rebate and Infrastructure Grant Program established in G.S. 113B-30."

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law. The State Energy
Office shall adopt the rules to implement the program established by this act on or
before January 1, 2004. This act shall expire on January 1, 2007.
